Federated States of Micronesia

A reduction in the spread and impact of HIV and other Sexually Transmitted Infections in the Federated States of Micronesia, through leadership of a supportive and collaborative environment free of stigma and discrimination.

SMILE: Safe Micronesia Indiscriminate Living Environment

Cook Islands

Maintain the current situation in which HIV is almost non-existent in the Cook Islands, reduce the prevalence of other STIs, and develop systems to ensure that treatment and community support will be available if people do become infected with HIV in the future.

Kiribati

Achieving together a supportive environment to reduce the impact of HIV and STIs on individuals, families and the community in Kiribati by 2015.

Marshall Islands

Establish a coordinated national response against HIV and STIs that promotes sexual and reproductive health, encourages respect amongst all individuals, families and the community, and acknowledges the strength of culture.

Solomon Islands

By 2018, halt the spread of HIV and reduce transmission of STIs through the reduction of risk and vulnerability in the Solomon Islands population, with specific focus on vulnerable groups.
