"Every Last Child" tells the story of the fight to end polio in Pakistan — one of just two countries worldwide where polio remains.

After premiering at the DOC NYC film festival in 2014, Every Last Child received glowing praise from critics at the New York Times, LA Times and Washington Post. To date, the film has only been screened at events in the USA and UAE.
